C. ACTION ON MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS:

The last meeting was held on 11 May 2011 and Chaired by ARNG. The Chairman published minutes and filed them as required. There were also no issues or concerns with last year's minutes. A motion to approve the minutes was made by the USNR, seconded by the USMCR and approved by all.

F. PROJECT RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. The purpose of this meeting was to review and revalidate the Reserve/National Guard Component major construction projects presented during the last meeting and to entertain, discuss, and make recommendations on new/future projects.

2. The Army National Guard updated the cost and fiscal year for Project #170113 and #170127A. In addition, the ARNG updated the fiscal year on Project #170033. The ARNG had no new projects brought forward for consideration.

ARNG anticipates the following projects to be added to next FYDP; N Riverside CSMS (FY18), Springfield USPFO (FY19), and Lawrenceville Readiness Center (FY 19).

3. The Illinois Air National Guard (ANG) updated the fiscal year to FY 2016 for Project #VDYD092010. The ANG had no new projects brought forward for consideration.

4. The USAR removed Project #CAR 10 70553 from the list since it is in construction. In addition, the USAR updated the fiscal year to FY 2012 for Project #CAR 11 67664. USAR also brought forward a new Army Reserve Center, Organizational Maintenance Shop, and Unheated Storage in Elwood, IL for joint consideration. It was determined this would be a joint project with the ARNG. A motion to approve this joint project was made by the USAR, seconded by the ARNG, and approved by all.

5. The USMCR had no new projects brought forward for consideration.

6. The USAFR had no new projects brought forward for consideration.

7. The USNR had no new projects and currently have no projects listed.

1. At the May 2009 JSRCFB it was discussed by the IL ARNG that they will be developing a list of new maintenance locations for the state in an effort to consolidate facilities. This effort has not been completed and is currently being revised by the G-4 of the ILARNG. This plan should be completed by the end of FY 2012 and will be discussed at the 2013 JSRCFB.
