F. Project recommendations.

The board is looking for opportunities for joint development and joint use of facilities in Alaska.

The USAR is planning to construct a new Armed Forces Reserve Center/OMS on JBER in the FY 19 time frame. They are interested in partnering with the AKARNG to construct a Joint Facility on JBER. Additionally, Mr. Mike Coy stated that once the USAR vacate their existing Reserve Center that facility would be available for the AKARNG or other Reserve Component to use.

The AKARNG is planning to construct a new Readiness Center in the Fairbanks Area in 2018. The USAR is interested in partnering with the AKARNG on this project.

With the increased relevance of the Arctic the AKARNG is looking to expand it facilities and capabilities in Barrow, AK. The AKARNG plans to partner with the USCG to construct a facility which can support the AKARNG, AKANG, and USCG mission and manning requirements. This project will most likely be funded through the State of Alaska.

Subject: Joint Service Reserve Component Facility Board (JSRCFB)

The AKARNG currently planning to construct a 25K SF addition on to Building 49000 on JBER this addition is to be funded by the State of Alaska and will be used to support joint operations with the USCG.

The USCG offered use of its facilities around the State to reserve components needing support.

Navy sees possible opportunity for joint usage with the Army National Guard Troop Medical Clinic on Camp Carroll, Fort Richardson.
