

2013 BOARD MEETING MINUTES OF THE JOINT SERVICE RESERVE COMPONENT FACILITY BOARD (JSRCFB) NEW HAMPSHIRE

A. CONVENING THE JSRCFB

In accordance with DOD Directive 1225.07, dated 6 June 2001, Certified Current as of April 23, 2007 and per last years board recommended meeting format, the Board held its annual Joint Service RC Facility Board Meeting via audio conference at the Construction and Facility Management Office at 1 Minuteman Way, New Hampshire, at 10:00 am on **9 May 2013**. Mr. Sargent, NHARNG, read the board purpose as written in DoDI 1225.8, "The mission for the Joint Service Reserve Component Facility Board (JSRCFB) is to maximize usage of Reserve component land, facilities, and installations by promulgating joint use by two or more components. Additionally, the JSRCFB shall pursue opportunities for shared use with any Active components in their area."

B. ATTENDANCE

Participants are authenticated by Attachment 1. In accordance with DOD Instructions 1225.8, the Board convened with representatives from the Marine Corps Reserves, Air National Guard, Army Reserve, and Army National Guard residing in New Hampshire. There is no Air Force Reserve unit presence in New Hampshire.

C. ACTION ON MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

Minutes of the previous meeting held 14 June 2012 were accepted without change.

See Attachment 2, Project Listing. Ed Sargent, NH Army National Guard Master Planner, lead discussions regarding ARNG projects. No other Reserves in attendance had projects in the New Hampshire area.

F. PROJECT RECOMMENDATIONS

1. NH ARNG Construction of a new Manchester Readiness Center is our TAG's top priority. The plan is to build a single unit Readiness Center in the Manchester Area and eliminate severe overcrowding in its existing Manchester facility. No other components had any interest in joint utilization and voted for the project to remain, **unilateral construction**, due to the fact that other components had adequate facilities and the proposed location was not favorable.

2. NH ARNG Construction of Readiness Center Space at the Army Aviation Support Facility (AASF) is our TAG's second priority. This Project will help eliminate overcrowding in its existing Concord facilities. No other components had any interest in joint utilization and voted for the project to remain, **unilateral construction**, due to the fact that other components had adequate facilities and the proposed location was not favorable.
3. NHARNG is seeking MILCON for a \$1.2 million Basic 25 Meter Rifle Range with twenty firing points at the Center Strafford Training Site. No other components have interest in joint utilization and this project will be **unilateral construction**.
4. NHARNG \$3.9 million Readiness Center Add/Alt. The Readiness Center in Lebanon is seriously undersized and addition would increase gross building square footage by adding multipurpose rooms, administration and storage space. Project is unique to the Army National Guard and recommended **unilateral construction**.
5. NHARNG \$3.9 million Readiness Center Add/Alt. The Readiness Center in Hillsborough is seriously undersized and addition would increase gross building square footage by adding multipurpose rooms, female latrine, administration and storage space. Project is unique to the Army National Guard and recommended **unilateral construction**.
6. NHARNG \$3.5 million Readiness Center Add/Alt. The Readiness Center in Littleton is seriously undersized and project would increase gross building square footage by adding multipurpose rooms, administration and storage space. Project is unique to the Army National Guard and recommended **unilateral construction**.
7. USAR- NH ARNG both have Keene Facilities to construct. Last year's board recommendation was joint construction with Army Reserve being the lead. Michael Lohan noted the project has remains #14 on their priority list for Construction. Project was reaffirmed, **joint construction**.

G. OTHER BUSINESS

- Ed Sargent spoke about the recent transfer of Raymond Bisson USARC to Army National Guard.
- Mike Lohan spoke about the 2005 BRAC resulting in the construction of a new USARC in Portsmouth slated to be complete mid August of this year. The old facility will be disposed.
- LTC Mikolaities asked the Army Reserves if they had any projects planned for the next decade. Mike Lohan replied none in New Hampshire for the next twenty years. LTC Mikolaities asked about their plan to replace Keene USARC and if it was still number 14 on their list. Michael Lohan confirmed it was and estimated selection for funding to be 20 to 25 years out unless there is another BRAC.

- LTC Mikolaities asked reserve components if there have been any gains or losses to force structure in the State. Murray Seals stated no changes for the USMCR. Michael Lohan stated no changes for the USAR.
- LTC Mikolaities asked if the USMCR would be interested in the construction and use of a 25 meter rifle range at the NH National Guard Training Site. Murray Seals stated the USMCR were satisfied with FT, Devens and would not be interested.
- LTC Mikolaities asked if there was any construction that ARNG could participate in that would accommodating. Michael Lohan stated that if ARNG had construction in Keene the USAR would be interested in a low dollar value (\$3-5 Million) they might be able to fund it as budget filler.
- Murray Seals asked if there would be a rotation in the JSRCFB Chair. LTC Mikolaities stated NH ARNG will continue.
- Mr. Sargent stated to all members meeting minutes will be circulated through email for their review and comment and asked they assist in the Authentication process by digitally signing attachment 1.




All business was concluded, Mr. Sargent called for completion of all matters before the Board ending meeting.


