

**FY 2013 MEETING MINUTES OF THE
JOINT SERVICE RESERVE COMPONENT FACILITY BOARD
STATE OF NEW YORK**

A. CONVENING THE BOARD

In accordance with DoD Directive 1225.07, dated 6 June 2001, certified current as of 23 April 2007, the New York State Joint Service Reserve Component Facility Board (JSRCFB) held its annual meeting convening at 1000 hours on 11 April 2013 at the Joint Force Headquarters (JFHQ) in Latham, NY. The meeting was chaired by LTC Andrew Stewart, NYARNG.

C. ACTION ON MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The board discussed the minutes from last year's JSRCFB, in particular the projects that were deemed possible joint construction. It was determined the best way to cover each project was to review the project listing. USAR requested that the Schenectady project be removed because construction has started and the Bullville project be removed because it is in design.

E. PROJECT LISTING

Reserve Component Project Listing for FY13 JSRRCFB - New York considered by this board can be found at Enclosure #1.

1. The New York Army National Guard (NYARNG) reviewed two projects funded in the current Future Year Defense Program (FYDP), neither of which are recommended for joint construction and five projects on their Long Range Construction Plan (LRCP), two of which were recommended for possible joint construction (Bronx and/or Queens with United States Marine Corps Reserve (USMCR). The NYARNG noted its number one and number two projects on the LRCP, Bronx and Queens Readiness Centers do not currently have land associated with them. The NYARNG also expressed interest in securing property with the USMCR at a location such as Floyd Bennett Field for the future Queens facility.
2. The United States Army Reserve (USAR) requested the board review seven projects on their LRCP, two of which were recommended for possible joint construction. Both the USAR and NYARNG show interest in building a facility in the Orangeburg, NY area and near Penn Yan-Geneva, NY.
3. The USMCR briefed their Brooklyn, NY project is a Vehicle Maintenance Facility (VMF) and could not be looked at for joint use.
4. The United States Navy Reserve (USNR) was not present at the meeting and did not submit any future projects for consideration.
5. New York Air National Guard (NYANG) was present at the meeting and briefed a project which is the relocation of supply facilities on their base. This project will not be looked at for joint use. Lt Col Randall from Stratton ANGB briefed that they have some green space (available land) that could be considered for use by any component that may require it.
6. The United States Air Force Reserve (USAFR) was present at the meeting and briefed that their current project (C-130 Flight Simulator) will be funded this year.

F. PROJECT RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Approved for joint construction and funded in the FYDP - None.
2. Possible joint projects:
 - a. Orangeburg, NY: The NYARNG and USAR have indicated the need for a new facility in Orangeburg, Rockland County. The NYARNG has a facility in Orangeburg with a total of 14 acres that is undersized for the assigned units. The USAR has a

facility on 20 acres that likewise requires replacement or total rehabilitation. The NYARNG and USAR propose the Department of Defense (DoD) support an AFRC in the Orangeburg area.

b. Penn-Yan, Geneva NY: The USAR is trying to develop a project for that area, but the unit is too small for a go it alone project. The possibility of a joint project with the NYARNG unit located at the NYS Armory in Geneva and acquiring new land, may work.

G. OTHER BUSINESS

1. The NYARNG discussed the joint use of training sites and discussed the topic of a joint use Regional Training Institute for all components to use.

2. The USAR will be meeting with the NYARNG in the near future to look over all USAR and NYARNG projects in detail.

H. NEXT MEETING


The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, 10 April 2014, at the JFHQ, Latham, NY.

The meeting adjourned at 1055 hours.


