- Army National Guard

Three projects addressed, two unilateral and one joint with USAR for PN: 220141



- Air National Guard

Three projects from last year were left on the project list. They were listed as Unilateral. There was no discussion since a representative from LAANG was not available for the meeting.

- Navy Reserve

Six projects were addressed with all proposed as unilateral projects.

- Marine Reserve

No projects submitted for review.

- Air Force Reserve

Two projects were added to the project list this year by Air Force Reserve Command. Both offered as unilateral. There was no discussion since a representative from USAFR was not available for the meeting..

Two projects were addressed with one as unilateral and one joint with LAARNG.

## **6. Discussion**

- Bill Lachicotte, USAR, began the meeting by calling role.
- The meeting minutes from 2013 were offered for discussion. With no comments, the minutes were accepted as presented. Doug Connor USMCR made the motion to accept minutes and Thomas Grantham USNR seconded.
- Next on the agenda was the review of projects. The review began with the Louisiana Army National Guard projects. Though six projects were mentioned, emphasis was given to the top two. The FY 21 project is a Readiness Center for HHC (-) 3/156 INF BN (IBCT). The project will be located at Chennault International Airport, Lake Charles, LA. The FY 22 project is a Readiness Center for HHC 256<sup>th</sup> IN BDE and will be located in Lafayette, LA. The USAR has expressed interest in Lake Charles RC as a joint project.
- COL Bordelon, ARNG, expressed interest in locating a small Army National Guard unit in the existing USAR facility at Lake Charles. LTC Welch, USAR, welcomed further discussion.
- The Air National Guard projects from last year were repeated on the project list but there was no discussion since there was not a representative at the meeting.
- The Navy presented six projects. The list included projects to Relocate the Main Gate, add a Joint Reserve Intelligence Center, Construct a Perimeter Road, Construct Flight Line Fence, Construct Water Quality improvements and Construct a Police Station Addition. All six projects were presented as unilateral.
- The USMCR indicated they do not have any projects in Louisiana this year.
- The USAR presented two projects; the first is the Army Reserve Center at NAS JRB Belle Chase. The second is the potential joint AFRC at Lake Charles with ARNG.

- The AFR provided two projects to be added to the project list this year. Both were presented as unilateral. There was no discussion since AFR did not have a representative at the meeting.
