#### F. OTHER BUSINESS

1. COL Steven Hines, representing the National Guard, stated on the projects list for the Army National Guard LRCP and Camp Atterbury are funded solely by us but usage could be joint on some of them. Shelbyville on the FYDEP for FY20, looking for joint facility with Air Guard Weather Flight. Looking for a partner in Hamilton # 2 for the planning process. Sites for joint potential are FY22 and beyond. Possible BRAC initiatives. Violable location located closer to larger towns. The projects could be with Army Reserve, Marine, or Navy that reside in that area. COL Hines talked about flush in Bloomington for BRAC joint project.

2. Mr. Ralph Thorn, representing the Army Reserves stated they are divesting of Anderson and Kessler Blvd locations. The Army Reserves is vacating 3500-3600sqft space at Crane Naval. They do not have anything for the next 10 years. Mr. Thorn stated they would go ahead and look at joint project for Bloomington. They not interested in Hamilton unless 100% funding from Army National Guard.

3. Col Colbert for the Air National Guard stated their projects are possible for joint usage but none of their projects are for joint funding.

4. Ms. Debra Ladd for the Naval Reserve stated they have no projects for the FYDP in Indiana.

5. Mr. Lee Stonestreet representing Air Force Reserve said they a small arms range possible for joint. They don't have anything further than FY17 on the project listings.

6. LtCol Berryman calls for a motion to accept projects, Mr. David Lindsey made motion to accept.

7. Under new business. Ms. Ladd talked about an old lease they are trying to get reconciled. COL Hines stated he would talk with the people to help get Ms. Ladd the final bill. Meeting to adjourn and set the 2016 meeting to be held 06April16 at 09:00 cst/ 10:00 est. Air Force Reserve will lead the 2016 meeting. All voted and

project listing was approved with no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned at 1130.
