- a. USAR

b. NYANG

LtCol Oaksford located in Syracuse, NY briefed the NYANG Syracuse projects and added 4 new projects to the listing. All projects in Syracuse were discussed and determined not to be a possible joint project.

c. USMCR

Mr. Craig Monroe briefed the USMCR projects and it was determined that at this time all projects listed are not possible joint projects. Mr. Monroe made the board aware that the USMCR will be moving out of the Farmingdale NGRC in the latter part of FY18. An additional note is that the Vehicle Maintenance Facility listed on the FY16 project listing will be completed this July and will not appear on next year's project listing.

d. NYARNG

COL Cleaveland and Mr. Wicks discussed the possibility in the future of a joint project, possibly an AFRC near Geneseo, NY and Orangeburg, NY. Also discussed was a possible joint venture on the land where the Creedmoor Psychiatric Center in Queens, NY was once located. The land would first need to be purchased by the State of New York and meet all environmental requirements prior to the Government fund any future MILCON project.

F. USNR

Ms. Johnston briefed the current facilities used by the USNR. When asked about the possibility of the USNR moving out of the Schenectady NOSC, it was stated she has no knowledge of the USNR moving out of that facility.

G. USAFR

Mr. Battista briefed the USAFR projects and it was determined the current projects listed have no joint requirement.
