SUBJECT: Meeting Minutes, 1 June 2016 State of Oregon State Facilities Board (SFB) (previously Joint Services Reserve Component Facility Board (JSRCFB))

1. CONVENING THE JSRCFB: In accordance with Department of Defense Instruction Number 1225.08 dated 10 May 2016, the Oregon State Facilities Board meeting commenced at 0900 hours, 1 June 2016, at the Joint Force Headquarters, 1776 Militia Way, Salem OR 97309.

2. ATTENDANCE: See enclosure 1, Board Membership Sheets.

3. ACTION ON MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS: No actions from previous meetings were required.

4. PROJECT SUMMARY:

a. Oregon Army National Guard (ORARNG) projects reviewed:

(1) The Top Ten ORARNG projects list was reviewed. One project was recommended for joint construction and nine were considered to be unilateral construction. The Klamath Falls AFRC is on the FY20 Future Years Defense Program (FYDP) and will be built as a joint facility with the Oregon Air National Guard (ORANG). Phase I (Security Forces Building) has already been completed and is occupied by the ORANG.

(2) Linn County Readiness Center is ORARNG's number two (2) priority and is recommended for joint construction with U.S. Army Reserve (USAR) units presently stationed in Eugene. This project contemplates two phases and would close the ORARNG Armory in Lebanon and the USAR Reserve Center in Eugene to build a new Armed Forces Readiness Center (AFRC) in Linn County.

(3) The other nine unilateral ORARNG projects are considered such at this time due to lack of other DoD agencies in the state with contemplated necessary projects that would align in similar timeframe or be compatible joint use. The one exception may be the ORANG project indicated below. However, the ORARNG would need an analysis from the ORANG indicating why this project could not accommodate site space/area for the planned FY 2026 Portland FMS.

b. ORANG at Portland Air National Guard (PANG) Base briefed one project.

(1) Build an Admin/Storage building to support the 125 FTS in FY27. This project will be built as a unilateral facility by the ORANG. The 142<sup>nd</sup> FW PANG Plan was briefed. PANG is restricted by acreage and the plan's revision is expected to be issued during October.

c. ORANG at Kingsley Field Air National Guard Base (KFANGB) briefed one project. A Corrosion Control Hanger is planned for FY19, though the ORANG is trying to move the project to FY18. This project will be built as a unilateral facility by the ORANG.

d. The U.S. Naval Reserve (USNR) plans to construct a small addition to their administration building on Swan Island in FY19.

e. The U.S. Army Reserve (USAR) is only planning on the possible joint facility with the ORARNG in Linn County.

f. The U.S. Marine Corps Reserve (USMCR) is planning a long range construction project for an Admin/Maintenance type facility in Portland. Interest was expressed in combining their facility with the ORARNG's plan to relocate Kliever and Gresham Armories within the Portland Metro area (FY31). USMCR requires 15 acres for their project.

5. PROJECT LISTING: See enclosure 2.

6. PROJECT RECOMMENDATIONS: See Discussion under Current Business.

7. CURRENT BUSINESS:

a. KFANGB - CMSgt Dominic Ingle: Phase II of the Joint AFRC project on KFANGB consisting of the ORARNG space is in the FYDP for FY20 construction; Phase I of this AFRC consisting of the ANG Security Forces Building is complete. A Corrosion Control Hanger on KFANGB is planned for FY19 and is to be built as a unilateral ANG project.

b. PANG - Capt Jon Corrigan: The PANG Site Usage Plan was discussed. The site is restricted in the amount of land that's available. A revision to the plan is expected in October 2016. One project was identified on PANG in FY27, an Admin/Supply building for the 125 FTS. This project is unilateral at this time.

c. USAR, 88<sup>th</sup> RSC ARIM - Ralph Thorn: The USAR units stationed in Eugene are candidates for re-stationing at a future AFRC in Linn County with ORARNG.

d. USNR - Rima Blackwell: Identified one USNR project in Oregon, an expansion of their Administration building on Swan Island. This is a unilateral project at this time.

e. USMCR - Charles Wyatt: Possible future project in the Portland area requires 15 acres and this facility is proposed to be collocated at the future site of the Gresham and Kliever Readiness Centers replacement.

f. ORARNG - Joanne Manson: Reviewed the ORARNG top ten prioritized Military Construction projects listed on Long Range Construction Plan (LRCP) for the Fiscal Year 2017 submission. ORARNG has two joint projects, Klamath Falls AFRC Phase II scheduled for FY20 on the FYDP and the Linn County AFRC Phase 1 scheduled to be built in 2023. ORARNG expressed interest in having other services become partners in future construction projects. ORARNG Top Ten projects are projected out to FY31.

8. NEXT MEETING: Wednesday, 7 June 2017 at the Oregon Military Department, 1776 Militia Way, Salem, Oregon; Room TBD – 0900 hours – Call-in information will be provided at least two weeks in advance of meeting.

9. ADJOURNMENT: The meeting adjourned at 1005 hours.

10. AUTHENTICATION: Enclosure 1 – Signatures represent attending members at the JSRCFB meeting. ORANG, USAR, USNR, and USMCR representatives participated via phone and electronically as other business precluded their attendance in person. All members agreed on the status of the project list and the possibility of joint construction was discussed for each future project.
