MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Joint Services Reserve Component Facility (JSRCFB) Board Meeting Minutes

1. In accordance with the DOD Directive 1225.07, dated 23 April 2007, the board held its annual meeting at 1030 hours on 08 March 2015 at the Massachusetts National Guard Joint Force Headquarters Building, 2 Randolph Road, Hanscom AFB, Bedford MA 01731.
2. The following individuals were in attendance either in person or by audio bridge:

3. Meeting began with acceptance of last year's minutes. MAJ Wiley MA-ARNG, motioned to accept. Last year's minutes accepted. Each component briefed their respective projects. The following is an overview of projects reviewed.
 - a. Number of projects reviewed: 30
 - b. Number recommended for joint construction: 4
 - c. Number recommended for unilateral construction: 26
 - d. Number not recommended for construction: 0

4. Project recommendations:

MAARNG: The Massachusetts Army National Guard presented a total of 6 projects for review. Four of the projects recommended for unilateral recertification. The projects consist of a new Readiness Center at Camp Edwards, Bourne, MA to support the 181 EN Vertical and an Add/Alt to the existing Lexington Readiness Center. Two (2) projects are ranges (MPMG and MRF) for an Army National Guard Training Site; these were certified as unilateral due to the training mission. All training facilities and ranges at the MTA Camp Edwards are available for joint use to support training requirements though construction is certified as unilateral. The MAARNG discussed West Boylston AFRC and FMS project as potentially joint projects with the USAR. Project still pending as MAARNG TAG priority. Project deemed not a priority project for the USAR at this time. MAARNG will continue to pursue land acquisition

USAR: The Army Reserve presented a total of 3 projects; all three were recertified unilateral due to geographic locations and specific mission requirements. The Roslindale ARC/OMS project was removed at the request of the USAR.

ANG: The Air National Guard presented a total of 19 projects, 6 projects at Otis ANGB and 13 at Westfield/Barnes ANGB; 13 projects were recertified unilateral due to geographic, stationing, and mission constraints while 3 new projects were certified unilateral due to geographic, stationing, and mission constraints. There was discussion for the Relocating Main Gate Entrance/Exit as a joint project with the MAARNG. MAARNG requested site plan of gate to determine ATFP impact on current facilities. There were no contacts from Otis ANGB at the meeting.

USAFR: The Air Force Reserve presented a total of 3 projects two of which were recommended for recertification of unilateral construction due to their geographic locations and specific mission requirements. The indoor range remained the priority project with Mass. Development at Westover AFB, other two projects unchanged.

USMCR: The USMCR presented 0 projects.

USNR: The USNR presented 0 projects.

5. There were no new issues presented to the Board. The meeting was adjourned at 1105 hrs. All matters brought before the board were discussed thoroughly and all matters were completed prior to adjournment.

6. The next JSRCFB meeting will be hosted by MA Army National Guard and is tentatively scheduled for 29 February 2017 at 1000 hrs. EST. The board agreed to conduct the next meeting at the Massachusetts National Guard Joint Force Headquarters at 2 Randolph Street, Hanscom AFB, MA. Additionally, re-authentication of the current minutes will be initiated by the Army National Guard if required.
