G. OTHER BUSINESS

1. Floor was opened for discussion: No new topics were discussed.

a) US Army Reserve:

1) SRM project at Lugenbeel ARC in Boise. Conceptual MEP expansion. Possible joint venture with IDARNG. Is there available land on the installation of Gowen Field? Are there any existing facilities that can be used? May request space from IDARNG for this project with regards to the RC transformation plan. No new discussion on this project since last JSRCFB FY17.

2) Conceptual SRM at Rainey ARC on Gowen Field to expand over-utilized MEP at AMSA - Consider MEP expansion options for a joint venture with IDARNG. No New discussion on this project.


- b) US Marine Corps Reserve:
  - 1) Current new construction project for Boise, Tank Vehicle Maintenance Facility has been pushed to the out years. FY is still to be determined.
  
- c) ID Air National Guard
  - 1) New Construction for the Main Gate Security. FY 17 funded. Est. completion date is 20 May 17. **Completed.**
  - 2) MSA Road Repair – NGB funded in design FY18. May have some taxiway issues.
  - 3) Taxiway E. – Design for FY20. NGB will only fund the authorized 75'. Need a total of 150'. IDARNG will contribute 50% for a full repair of taxiway.
  - 4) Maintain Aprons and Taxiways – Planned for FY20. Holding for funding. Needs maintenance annually. No assistance needed.
  - 5) Installation of new Pop up Security Barriers – Planned for FY21. Could have new main entry issues. Decisions needed on where the main gate should be. 2 new barriers are needed.
  
- d) Navy Reserve: Nothing reported..
  
- e) Idaho Army National Guard:
  - 1) DAGIR is on track for construction for FY18 for \$22 mil for the OCTC. Currently on FYDP
  - 2) Jerome County RC and the FMS at the same site have been accepted on the FYDP for FY 22 & 23. Bonneville County RC is the TAG #1 for the LRCP.
  - 3) The CUFR list includes an Enlisted Barracks, Transient Training at the cantonment area, Aircraft Maintenance Hangar, General Instruction Bldg. & Troop Clinic / Health Dispensary on GF, Transient UPH, Advanced Skills Trainees (RTI barracks) on GF, and an Enlisted Barracks, Transient Training rebuild for five barracks on GF, funded for construction in FY 18.
  - 4) The primary training site project is a Multi-Purpose SCOUT / RECCE Gunnery Complex on the OCTC.
