MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: State Facility Board (SFB) Meeting Minutes

1. In accordance with the DOD Directive 1225.07, dated 23 April 2007, the board held its annual meeting at 1000 hours on 08 March 2017 at the Massachusetts National Guard Joint Force Headquarters Building, 2 Randolph Road, Hanscom AFB, Bedford MA 01731.

2. The following individuals were in attendance either in person or by audio bridge:

3. Meeting began with acceptance of introduction and roll call of members. Each component briefed their respective projects. The following is an overview of projects reviewed.

- a. Number of projects reviewed: 26
- b. Number recommended for joint construction: 2
- c. Number recommended for unilateral construction: 22
- d. Number not recommended for construction: 0
- e. Number removed from last year: 2

4. Project recommendations:

MAARNG: The Massachusetts Army National Guard presented a total of six (6) projects for review. All of the projects recommended for unilateral recertification. The project of a new Readiness Center at Camp Edwards, Bourne, MA has been accepted and is now on the FYDP for 2024. A new Readiness Center at Camp Curtis Guild to support the new Cyber Command. Two (2) projects are ranges (MPMG and MRF) for an Army National Guard Training Site; these were certified as unilateral due to the training mission. All training facilities and ranges at the MTA Camp Edwards are available for joint use to support training requirements though construction is certified as unilateral. The MAARNG discussed West Boylston AFRC and FMS project as potentially joint projects with the USAR. Project still pending as MAARNG TAG priority. The USAR has a potential interest in the West Boylston project and will be kept informed of the status once new Master Planner is hired.

USAR: The Army Reserve presented a total of one (1) project (Worcester Readiness Center); which was recertified unilateral due to geographic locations and specific mission requirements.

ANG: The Air National Guard 102nd presented a total of 3 projects, all three were certified as unilateral. One (1) existing project at Otis ANGB was removed as it is SRM.

The Air National Guard 104th Westfield/Barnes ANGB presented seven (7) projects that were recertified unilateral due to geographic, stationing, and mission constraints while one (1) project was added and certified unilateral due to current in process status. Removed one SRM project at Barnes.

USAFR: The Air Force Reserve presented a total of 6 projects two of which were recommended for recertification of unilateral construction due to their geographic locations and specific mission requirements. The indoor range is being solicited for construction, the other three (3) projects remain unchanged. There is possible interest in the Indoor Range becoming a joint project with the MANG 104th Fighter Wing.

USMCR: The USMCR presented 0 projects. Has no projects planned or in execution in Massachusetts. USMCR moved to accept 2018 minutes, motion approved and passed.

USNR: The USNR presented 0 projects.

5. There were no new issues presented to the Board. The meeting was adjourned at 1030 hrs. All matters brought before the board were discussed thoroughly and all matters were completed prior to adjournment. There were no UMMC or Minor MILCON projects provided for discussion by any component.

6. The next SFB meeting will be hosted by MA Army National Guard and is tentatively scheduled for 04 March 2020 at 1000 hrs. EST. The board agreed to conduct the next meeting at the Massachusetts National Guard Joint Force Headquarters at 2 Randolph Street, Hanscom AFB, MA. Additionally, re-authentication of the current minutes will be initiated by the Army National Guard if required.
